BP 5307 PUBLIC AND STAFF COMPUTING RESOURCES USE

Public access to the library computers is available to all users of the Hammond Public Library. All users are expected to use these resources in a responsible manner, consistent with the educational, informational, and recreational purposes for which they are provided and to follow published guidelines.

Staff computing resources are to be used to advance the Library's vision and mission. Staff may use them only for purposes related to the discharge of their duties as employees, their official business with the Library, and other Library-sanctioned activities, following published guidelines.

The Internet and its available resources contain a wide variety of material and opinions from varied points of view. In offering Internet access, library staff cannot control web site content beyond its own web site, which often change rapidly and unpredictably. Users are responsible for the web sites they reach. Parents or legal guardians of minor children must assume responsibility for their children's use of the Internet through the Library's connection.

The library offers free wireless access for library patrons to use with their own personal devices. These access points are unsecured and follow the library's CIPA filtering regulations. A patron's use of this service is governed by the Guidelines for Public Computing Resources and Wireless Access policies.
